These packs will include lanyards will be specific to each member and must be worn for entry to activities and for the provision of pre-paid meals. One lanyard will be allocated to each person who enters and will contain the details of meals and other activities that have been paid for in the member's entry. Packs will also contain a windscreen sticker for each car that the member has entered into the Show and Motorsport Day. It is recommended that these stickers aren't applied until at the event as dew or frost can damage the printing on them.

Saturday 9th June 2018

The Show 'n' Shine will be held again this year at the McRae HSV dealership, 182 Melbourne Rd, Wodonga VIC 3690 and is being organised by the ACT Club at a very reasonable \$10.00 per vehicle entry cost.

How to get there: Take the Melrose Drive exit from the southbound Hume Freeway, turning left and heading south. Turn right into Melbourne Road from the roundabout and continue past McRae HSV which is on your right. Do not turn right into McRae HSV. Do a U Turn at the first roundabout and then turn left into McRae HSV. If a queue develops, keep to the left out of the traffic lane.

McRea HSV will be holding a BBQ and coffee as previous year, plus are trying to get Supercar teams. They are looking at stuff for the kids as well. Like in previous years we will be setting up in clubs, and will

be not only competing with each other, but as clubs for the HSV Fest Show n Shine Shield.

The Classes for the Show 'n' Shine are:

Concourse (Cars travelled less than 5000km a year and includes the current year's model)

Show'n'Shine (Cars travelled between 5000km to 10000km a year)

Daily Driven (Cars travelled more than 10000km a vear)

Modified (Cars that have more than 5 significant modifications must enter this Class. For example, a set of Simmons rims is classed as 4 modifications)

Judging will be conducted in 4 broad categories and scored out of 100. A maximum of 30 points will be awarded for Exterior (Paint work, glass & lights, body & trim condition), Interior (Dashboard, steering wheel, console, pedals, doors, carpets & floor covering, headlining seats and seat-belts) and Engine Bay (Engine, engine bay, underside of bonnet, firewall, build plates, decals, exhaust system, intake system) categories and a maximum of 10 points for Wheels & Tyres (General cleanliness, scratches, blemishes). Each judge will assess only one category in order to maintain consistency. Judges will be appointed from each State Club and cannot assess their own cars. Results will be announced at dinner that evening.

The number of entries will determine the number of trophies.

After the Show and Shine, there is a choice of 4 activities.

- A Dyno Shootout at LS Engineering, 3/10
 Trafalgar St West Wodonga, VIC (just around the corner from the Show) starting at 1:30pm. Cost is \$55.00 per entrant and everyone gets 2 runs, a dyno sheet plus bragging rights.
- A drive to a local Winery being organised by Pete Eastwood.
- 3. A family friendly cruise to Bright being organised by the Albury Chapter.
- 4. An afternoon chill out at the members discretion organised by yourself.

The Saturday night 2 course dinner will be held at the Thurgoona Country Club Resort, 1 Evesham Place, Thurgoona NSW 2640. The Show 'n' Shine presentation will take place at this dinner. Meals from the fixed price Menu (below) will also need to be prepaid.

A coach from the Siesta Resort to the Thurgoona Country Club will be available and tickets for seats prepurchased with entries. Pricing will be \$8.00 per seat for the return trip and will need to be prepaid.

Sunday 10th June 2018

Sunday is a Motorsport Fun Day at the Wodonga Motorsport Complex. It will start off with timed track sprints followed after lunch with Go to Whoa Eliminations then Motorkhana Eliminations on a layout specially designed to suit our larger, powerful cars.

There will be a limit of 60 cars to ensure maximum track time. Entry priority will be given to cars that were in the Show 'n' Shine the previous day and the balance will be based on the earliest entry date.

Cost will be \$75.00 per vehicle which includes a sausage sandwich lunch and will need to be prepaid. Spectators can also prepay the same lunch for just \$5.00.

Entrants will be allocated competition numbers and divided into Groups of up to 12 competitors. Competition and Group numbers will be pre-printed on the event windscreen stickers.

Cars will undergo scrutineering safety checks prior to lining up on their Groups. Cars may not have any loose items in the cabin, any cameras must have a secondary mount (cable ties) to prevent them hitting the driver if they come loose, battery's must be firmly clamped and no fluid leaks will be allowed (water condensation excluded).

Track Sprints

Competitors are to line up in their respective Groups and will be let out onto the track in competition number sequence. The initial group does not need to be formed in number sequence as that will be organised by officials when commencing each Group's first run.

Cars are to form a queue (in number order) at the start line and when given the starting instruction proceed at pace until crossing the timing line at the finish before bringing the car to a complete stop before the control line. When stopped, competitors will be able to see the time for their run and then proceed to queue back with their Group in competition number order. This will be repeated for three runs.

Go to Whoa

At 12:00pm competition will cease for 30 minutes while officials have lunch and set up the Go to Whoa course. All vehicles will be relocated by driving around the track and forming a queue at the control line at the end of the track, facing the Go to Whoa course entry.

Vehicles will be called to pre-staging, then side by side into 2 staging areas before moving to side by side two start lines. Upon the drop of the starters arms both cars are to race in a straight line to their respective "garages" (marked by cones) at the end of the course. The first car to come to a complete halt entirely within their garage is the winner of that round and then proceeds by turning left and staging with the other round winners alongside of the concrete wall on the other side of the competition course. Each car that has been eliminated is to turn right and proceed around the track and join the queue for the next run. Cars will be disqualified for starting before the starters arms (not body) start to move. Dead heats will be re-run. Judges decisions will be final.

Once every car has had a run, the winners of the previous elimination will compete against each other in the same manner until only one car remains and that car will be the winner of that round.

Motorkhana

At around 1:30 there will be a short break while officials set up the Motorkhana course. This course will be the same as the Go to Whoa except that drivers will be required to negotiate 3 sets of cones between the start line and their "garage" in a manner similar to a

slalom. Both cars must go to the right of the first set of cones after the start – then to the left of the next set and to the right of the last set before entering the "garage".

Eliminations will proceed in the same manner as with the Go to Whoa with the exception that cars who hit a cone will be disqualified.
