- **8. Event Format:** This event is **Multi-Club Motorkhana**, and the event will be held as per National Motorkhana Code and 2021 Motorkhana Test Booklet.
- 9. Entries
 - a) Maximum number of entries for the Event: 65
 - b) Maximum number of people per vehicle is two.
 - Members of the following invited clubs are eligible to enter:

- d) Opening Date: 1st February 2021
- e) Fees: Club Member \$ 80.00 including a bbq lunch.
- f) Closing Date: 7th May 2021 Late Fee: No late entries.
- g) Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and must be submitted online via the www.HSVFest.com website. Priority will be given to Show n Shine entrants.

- h) If a competitor advises the event secretary that he/she is unable to attend the event, the following procedure regarding a refund applies:
- i) Full refund up to and including 7th May 2021 provided that notice is given in writing (email acceptable) and is acknowledged. No refunds after 7th May 2021, including a no-show on the day.
- j) The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 33 of the 2021 Motorsport Australia Manual.

10. Number of instructors: Minimum of 2 per session

Qualifications - Club Approved (min 2 years motorsport experience)

11. Minimum licences:

Motorsport Australia Non-Speed Licence/Junior or Motorsport Australia Introductory and current HSV Owners Club Membership. Both will be checked prior to the Event.

12 Driver Safety.

- a) A helmet and fire extinguisher are <u>NOT REQUIRED</u>. Unless you are driving a Motorkhana Special.
- b) non-flammable clothing, including cover from throat to wrists to ankles (apparel/footwear of Nylon or similar material is forbidden).
- c) Adequate footwear must be worn while competing. Bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted. and
- d) in open cars, goggles or a visor with a lens material other than glass (to AS1609).
- e) A speed limit of 10 km/h applies in the paddock area & when proceeding between tests.

13. Vehicle Check Requirements - Basic vehicle safety check.

- a) Vehicles to be in a sound roadworthy condition.
- b) All loose items must be removed from the vehicle.
- c) Maximum noise limit: 95 dba at 30 metres. Any car found to exceed the maximum noise emission limit will be suspended from the Event until the Clerk if the Course is satisfied that action has been taken to bring it within the limit.
- d) All vehicles will be assigned a Number which will be applied during venue entry. Vehicles are to assemble in groups for the exercises based on these numbers.
- e) Vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- **14. Drivers' Briefing** is compulsory (**all** competitors must attend and sign attendance sign-on sheet). Failure to attend or sign on will result in penalties being applied by the Clerk of Course. Appropriate Social distancing is to be maintained as required at the time.

- **20. Postponement/abandonment/cancellation.** The organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event.
- 21. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances.

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

- 22. Refreshment facilities: A pre-paid lunch will be provided
- **23.** Additions and/or alterations. Any additions and/or alterations to these Regulations will be notified to all competitors during the Drivers' Briefing.
- **24. Acceptable Vehicles:** Only HSV and HDT approved Club vehicles permitted to enter this event
- **25. Details of Training:** There will a maximum of 3 training exercises used orange rubber markers or witches hats will be used to mark out the course
 - All cars will be parked behind a concrete barrier whilst training exercises are taking place
 - Cars will be fed anti-clockwise from behind the barrier onto the course
 - An experienced Club member will call up the next car and another will start each car from the marked starting position, only when it is safe to do so
 - No pedestrians will be allowed on the course during the training exercises
 - In the event of a marker becoming displaced, the exercise will be stopped by the starter who will then permit entry onto the course by an authorised person to reposition the marker
 - The only passengers allowed are instructors or when participants are driven by an instructor for education purposes
- **26. Protests:** Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with NCR's 94-100 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
